The New Testament

This New Testament module picks up where *The Story of Jesus* module leaves off, giving students an understanding of the early church. Students will explore the church from its inception with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Peter, Paul and John describe this in their letters to the churches. They will see how the church and its people are the plan for redemption given by God until Jesus returns. This will be a springboard for students thinking about themselves as an integral part of the church, and how they are called to participate in God's mission.

Objectives

Key Knowledge

- Stories of the early churches and the journeys of Paul
- Understanding of the different genres in the New Testament and the purpose of each type of writing
- Understanding of how the Holy Spirit was at work through people to grow his church

Key Beliefs

- The Holy Spirit, who was at work in the New Testament, is at work in me and in the church today.
- I am an integral part of the church (Christ's body) and, as such, have much to learn about how to live from the instructions given in the letters of the New Testament.

Suggested Faith Practices

- Prayer: praying for others (intercessory prayer)
- Scripture: studying scripture
- Life: living in community
