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Games and Activities – Part One

1. Mix and match cards


(See appendix 1 for the template)

You will need:

- Make copies of the card sets on card stock
- Textas, crayons or coloured pencils for colouring if desired

What to do:

1. Print and cut out enough sets of cards for each person, pair or group. You might like to laminate the cards.
2. Have a “bad” fruit card set for each person/group.
3. Hide the “good” fruit cards around the room for them to find and match.
4. Or have a whole set and they can play memory (matching the bad and good fruit).



2. Old and New Testament games

You will need:

- A4 paper to make signs
- Index cards (for Game 2)
- Textas
- Bible



What to do:

Game 1

1. Make an Old Testament and New Testament sign.
2. Attach the Old & New Testament signs to opposite walls of your room.
3. Have the participants stand in the middle.
4. Call out a book of the Bible and have the children run to the sign of the testament they think it's in.

NB: This game can be played for points or not; if you want to make it a little more competitive for older kids, you could make it an elimination game – if they get it wrong, they are out!

Game 2

1. Using index cards, print one book of the Bible on each card.
2. Put them in a pile on the floor in the middle of the room.
3. Attach the Old & New Testament signs to opposite walls of your room.
4. Tell the participants, when you say ‘go’ they should grab a card and take it to its correct location.

NB: All participants play at once. The goal is to see how fast the group can divide the cards into their correct location.
